## INSTRUMENTAL TUITION

Instrumental tuition is available in the following instruments: flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, guitar, bass guitar, vocals, keyboard violin and drums.

Lessons begin in Week 3 and are held during school time in groups of 2-5 students.

Pupils receive approximately 32 lessons per year. (8 lessons per term)

### FEES:

The fees are: \$250.00 per annum if paid in Term 1 or \$75.00 per term.

Fees are expected to be paid within two weeks of class commencement.

If no fees have been paid within that time, the student will be withdrawn from tuition.

There may be additional costs for music or hire of instruments.

### INSTRUMENT HIRE:

Instruments are available for hire through *The Music Machine*. Ph 835 5183.

If you are keen, we suggest you organise the hire now, so your instrument is ready for 2011.

Some instruments are available to hire from school - flute, clarinet, saxophone, and trumpet.

### PUPIL OBLIGATIONS:

It is important that pupils are aware of their obligations with regard to music tuition. Please discuss the items below with your child:

- **LESSON DAYS/TIMES** - all pupils should know the day/venue/time of their weekly lesson and ensure they arrive promptly. Information regarding lessons is posted on the notice board outside the music room or in the daily notices. It is the pupil's responsibility to read the notices.
- **PREPARATION** - pupils are expected to practise during the week and turn up to lessons fully prepared with their instrument and music.
- **COMMUNICATION** - if pupils no longer wish to learn an instrument, parents/caregivers must inform the office. There are no refunds if a pupil stops tuition mid-term.
- **COMMITMENT** - pupils have made a commitment to learn an instrument - stay with it because this is a wonderful opportunity.

### THEORY CLUB

Due to time limitations, it is often difficult for teachers to teach the theory of music at the same time as practical music. Our theory club allow students to work through the ABRSM grade system and have the opportunity to sit an exam at the end of the year. Lessons are held in school time. The cost involved is \$54. \$27 for the work book and \$27 for the examination. The ABRSM may increase this fee in 2012.
